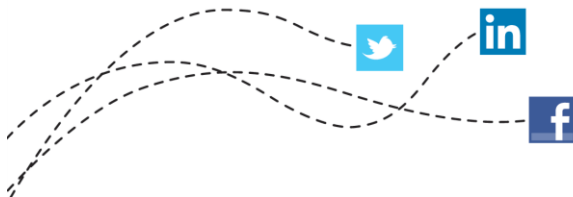
Special Interest Groups/Committees:

ACDM Accreditation Programme

The ACDM has developed a series of accredited training courses, specifically developed to provide a solid foundation in Clinical Data Management. In association with the International Academy of Clinical Research, these unique courses are initiated with the fundamentals of data management, enabling steady progression through levels to cover technical skills, and advanced project leadership skills with key objectives and learning outcomes.

With the aim of educating Clinical Data Managers to empower them to fulfil their roles in clinical development, the courses consist of comprehensive coursework, webinars and interactive sessions, and uniquely provide independently recognised (OfQual, ISCED & UNESCO), competence-based qualifications. On completing the courses, you will not only be ACDM certified, but accumulate industry recognised Continuing Professional Development (CPD) points.



Designatory letters are awarded to those completing the Certificate Level 1, 2 & 3 which provides an indication to organisations and other professionals that the learner has passed an independently verified accreditation process and is able to perform their role effectively.
